BRH ViaBus wins eight-year Hanau contract, starting in June 2018

The MET subsidiary submitted the best quality, most cost-effective bid in the Europe-wide tender and will run seven regional bus routes from 24 June 2018.

Routes 562 (Nidderau-Bruchköbel-Hanau), 563 (Altenstadt-Bruchköbel-Hanau), 566 (Großkrotzenburg-Hanau) and four school bus routes (561-566) form the basis of the contract. By December 2018, the distance covered along the seven routes will more than double to almost 1.1m kilometres per year.

The tender, by Frankfurt regional transport authority, RMV, will see the introduction of modern and some new, energy-saving, air-conditioned and comfortable vehicles with improved customer information systems. The low-floor buses are able to “kneel” down so that older or disabled passengers or those with wheelchairs or buggies can easily board. The tender was also designed to improve bus services for school children in and around Hanau.

Heiko Schütte, Managing Director of BRH ViaBus said, “We very much look forward to placing our buses and drivers into the heart of the community in Hanau and making bus journeys there more comfortable, more reliable and accessible.”
