MET orders new fleet of Iveco buses for airport and suburban routes in Frankfurt

An order for 12 new, low floor, Iveco buses has been placed by MET subsidiary, BRH viabus. The new buses will begin operations from December 2016 on LGG Flughafen Sued Linie 751 and Hanau routes.

The route contracts were signed with the regional transport authority for Frankfurt, Rhein Main Verkehrsverbund, and will each run for a period of eight years. The new fleet will be built to full low floor specification and are fitted with the latest, cleaner running Euro 6 engines.

MET Chief Executive, David Leeder, said: "Following successful trials with six Iveco Crossway LE buses, which were introduced into service in February 2016, we have ordered a further 12."

BRH viabus Managing Director, Heiko Schuette, said: "Our new Iveco fleet will provide improved standards of passenger comfort and reliability in our Frankfurt business."
